5. Copy of I.D. Card or Passport.			
6. A declaration whether the applicant intends to provide the services on a temporary or full-time basis. The declaration will also be necessary to inform the Building Regulation Office of any material change that might be experienced in future. The declaration must be in writing and submitted to the Building Regulation Office every year.			
7. Other relevant documentation.
